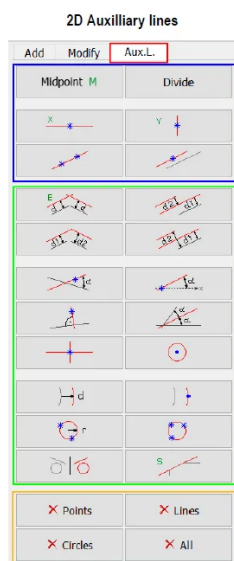
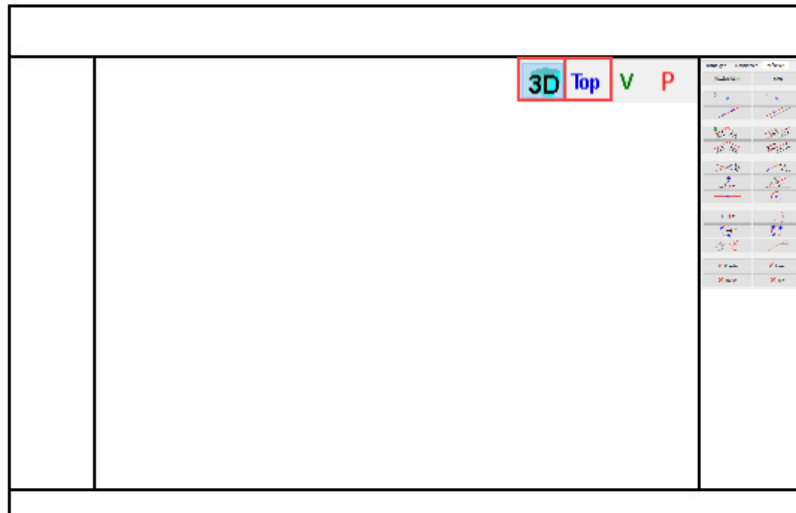


2.6.4 Auxilliary lines

In the right-hand menu, under the "Auxilliary lines" tab, it is possible to perform various functions in order to create constructions help lines, circles and points, which are then displayed in dotted lines. As a general rule, these construction lines are used as auxiliary elements and then deleted.

There are more constructional lines available in 2D views than in 3D views.



Blue points are the points to be defined to create the construction elements (point, line or circle). The created elements always go through these points. As applicable, an additional distance can be requested (e.g.: parallel, angle, radius, ...). The red line corresponds to the added construction element. Green letters are keyboard shortcuts.

These functions (except functions with keyboard shortcuts E and S) can only be used in 2d viewers, Top, V or P or in a cross section (layer 2D)

By clicking on "All", all auxilliary lines are removed. Otherwise it is possible to remove only points, lines or circles. To remove an auxilliary line, simply click on it
